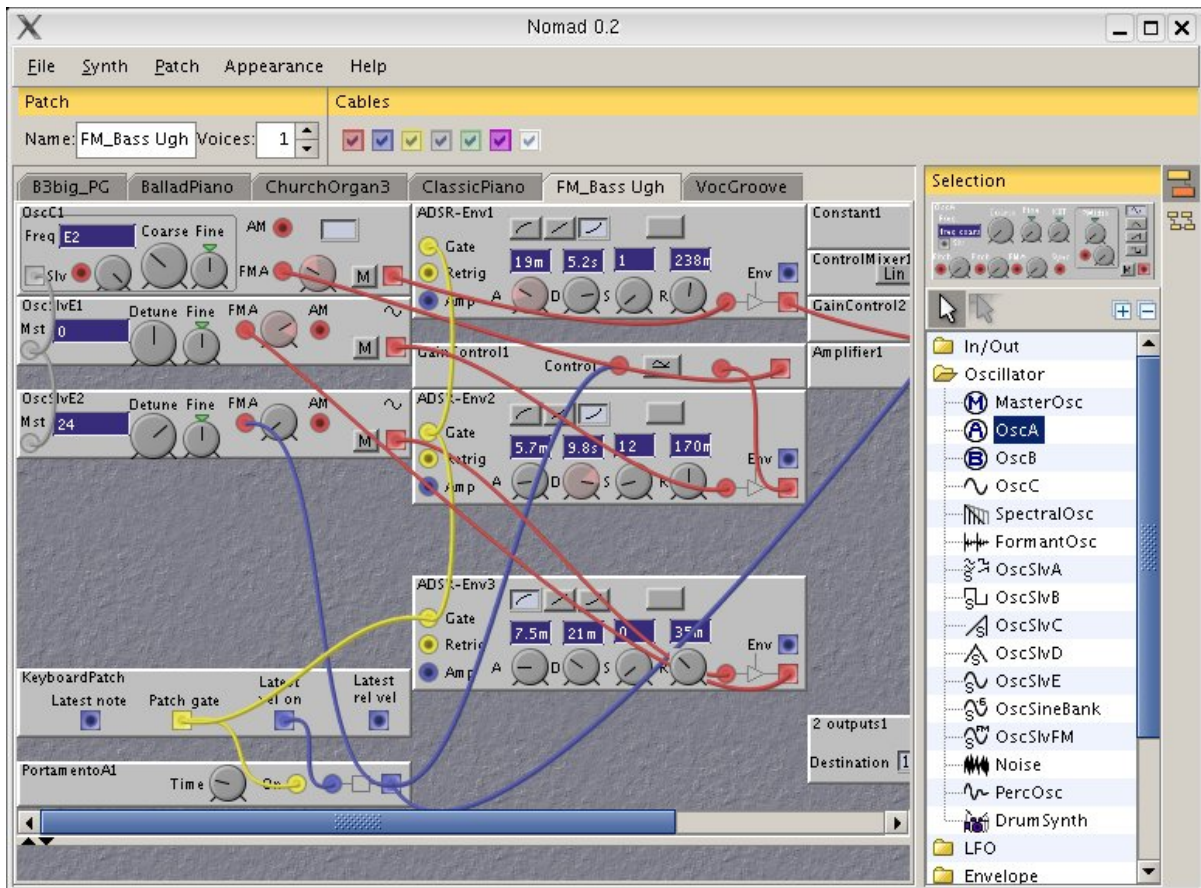

1.2. Nomad v0.2 - Toolbar replacement (2006-06-29)

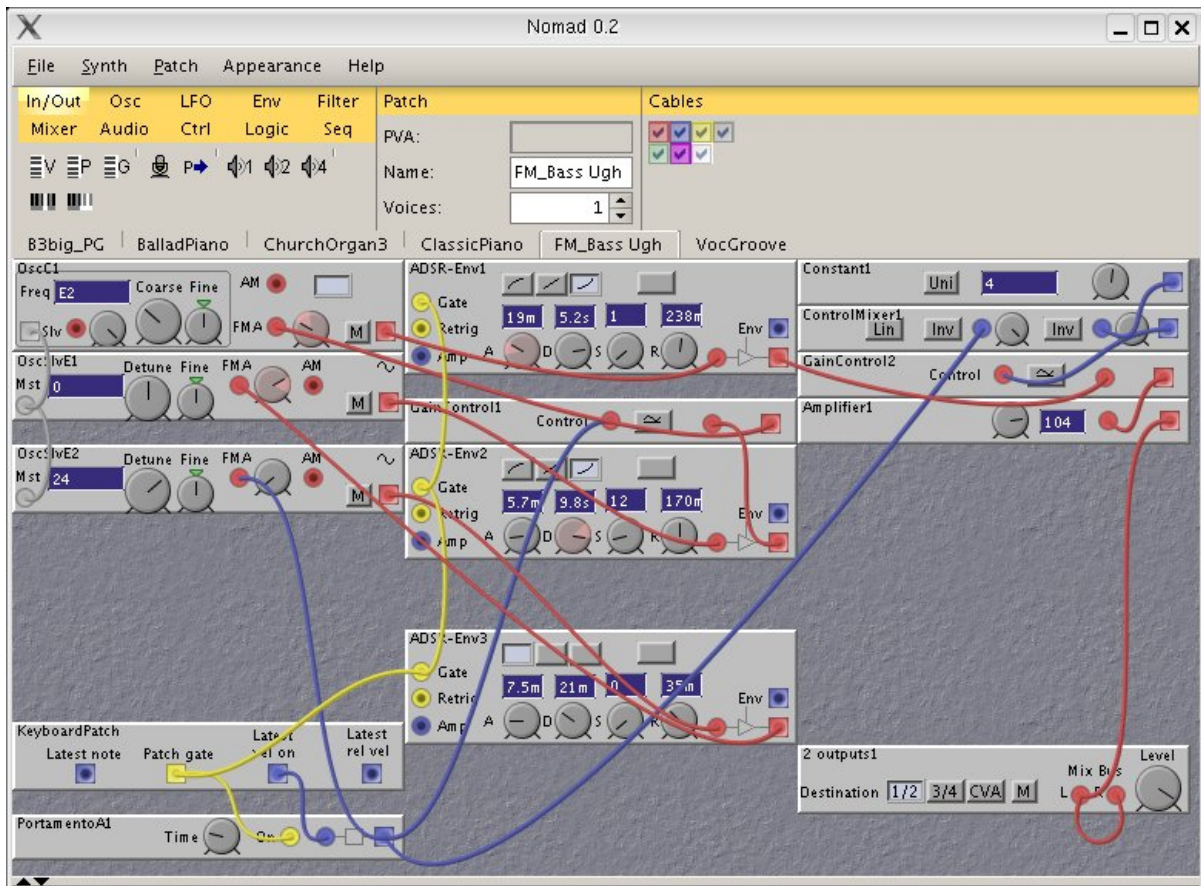

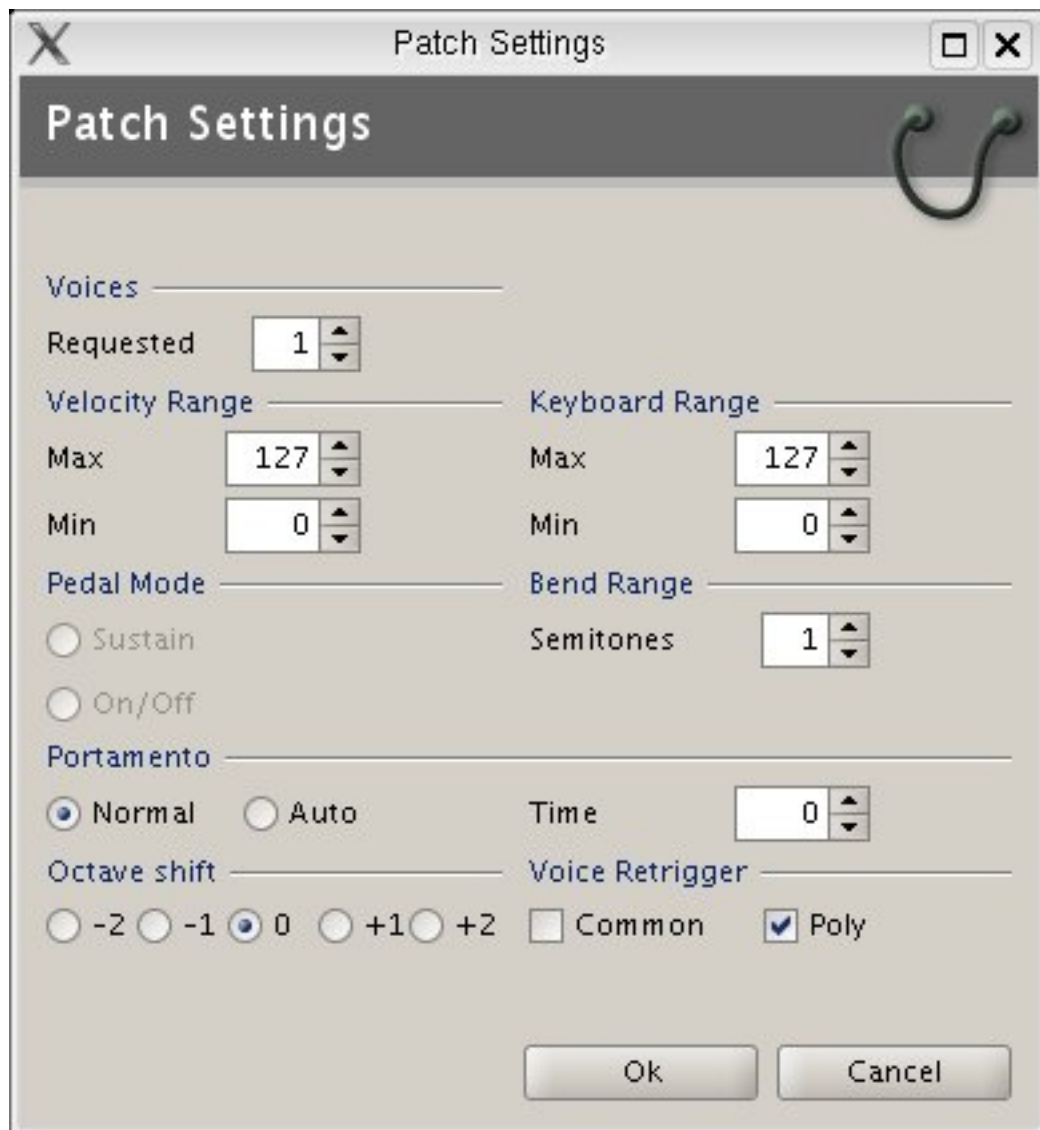
This screenshot shows the toolbar replacement. Using a tree to show the available modules has several advantages:

- The sidebar visibility can be changed, thus more space is left for displaying the patch

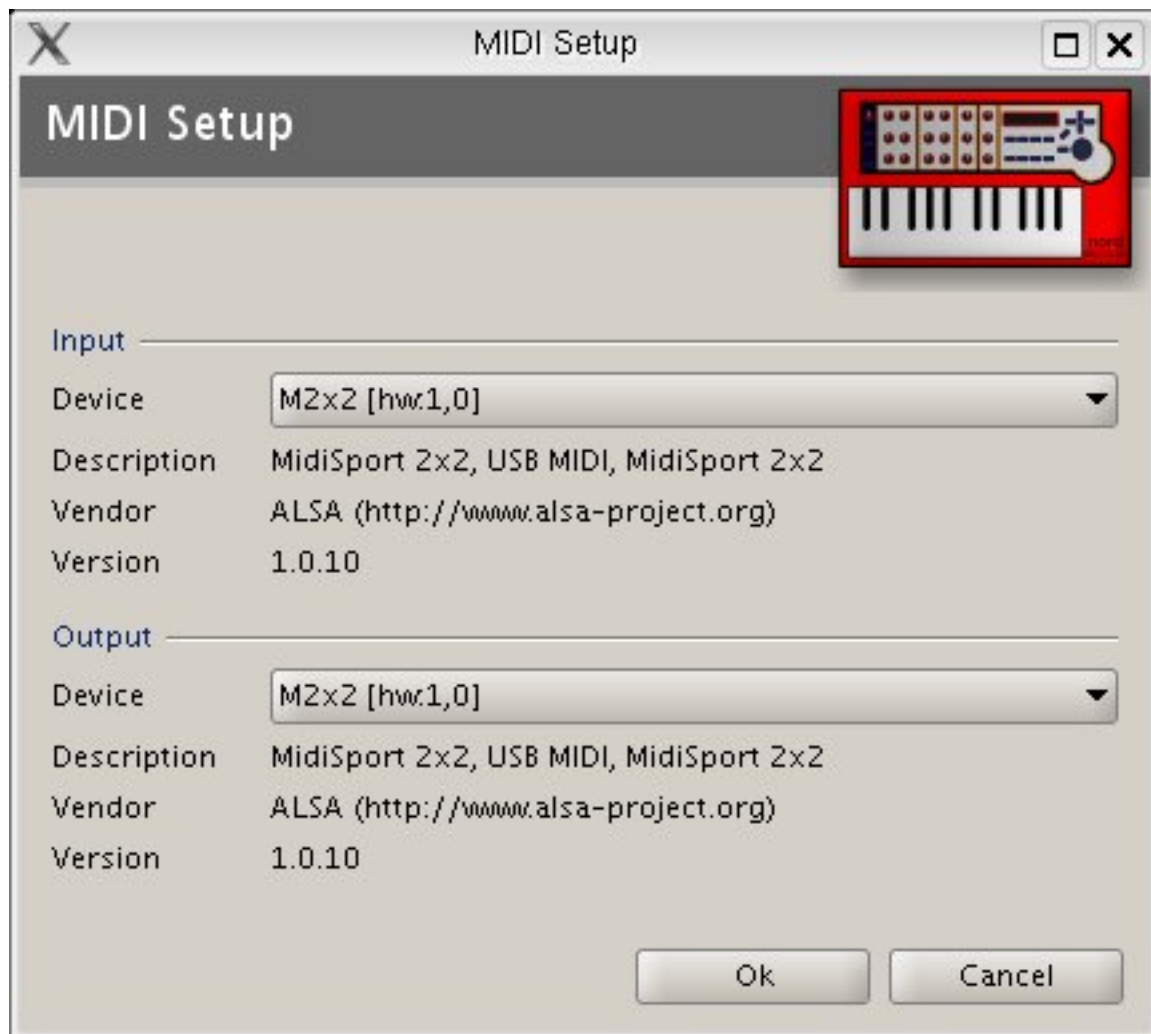

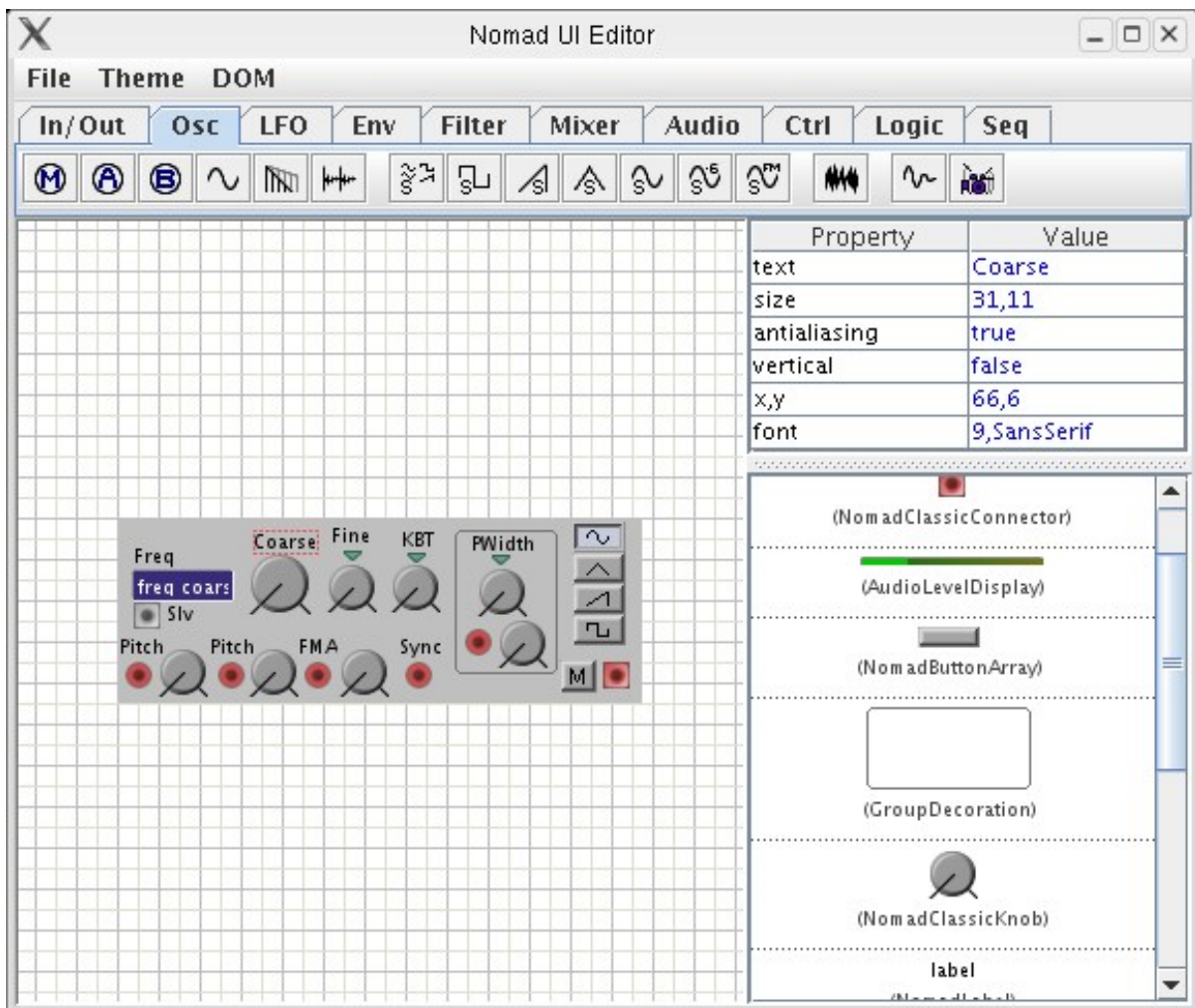

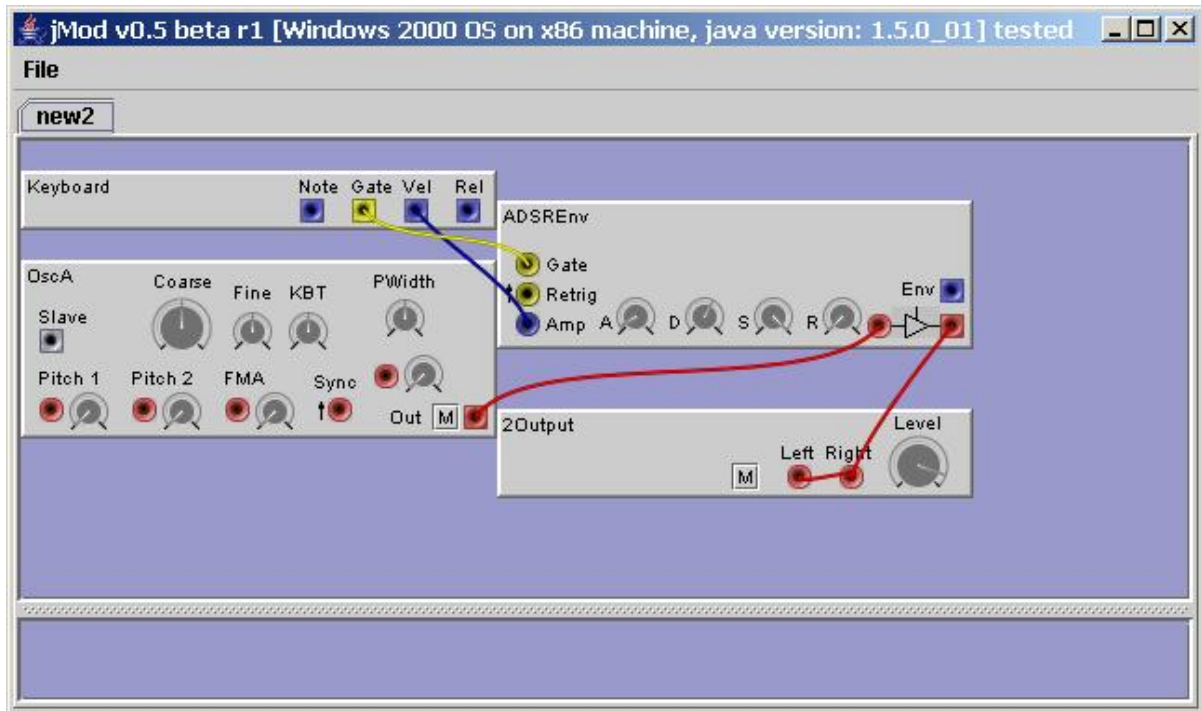
